

PARENT INVOLVEMENT IN THE SELECTION OF ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS, PRINCIPALS AND ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENTS

The Board of Education recognizes that parents should play an important role in the process by which the District selects certain administrators.

In the event of a vacancy for the position of building assistant principal, building principal, or District assistant superintendent, the Board of Education will authorize the PTA/PTSA of the affected building to select two parent representatives to participate on a Selection Committee. Their role shall be to:

- Review the resumes of candidates chosen by the professional staff to be interviewed;
- Attend all interview sessions;
- Attend any activity in which a Selection Committee takes part, such as school visitations.

For an assistant superintendent position, the Board of Education will authorize the UPTC to select two parents to participate on that Selection Committee.

The Board also encourages constituent groups to meet and develop criteria for selection based on a range of opinion. In the case of parent groups, the Board authorizes the Superintendent and/or his/her designee to invite all affected parents to participate in a forum prior to the review of résumés. Secondary school students will be invited to participate in a forum if the vacancy has occurred in the building they attend. The District shall provide training for all parent members of Selection Committees.

All parents will be expected to avoid conflicts of interest and maintain the same strict standard of confidentiality that is required of all District Selection Committees.
