

STUDENT DELEGATES TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Secondary school students selected by their student bodies shall serve as delegates to the Great Neck Board of Education. The Board values their opinions regarding educational and student matters.

North and South High Schools shall each select four (4) student delegates to the Board of Education, the Village School shall select one (1) delegate, and North and South Middle School shall each select three (3) delegates. Principals are asked to reach out to all incoming students to encourage them to run for student delegate positions.

The building principal shall submit the name(s) of the selected delegate(s) in writing to the Office of the Superintendent of Schools no later than September 30th. Should a student delegate vacancy arise during the school year, the respective student government will select a replacement.

Student delegates shall:

- Attend public meetings of the Board of Education;
- Serve a one-year term from the date of the first October Board of Education meeting through the date of the last Board of Education meeting in June;
- Serve in a consultative and advisory capacity without any voting rights, and not as members of the Board of Education;
- Be seated at public Board meetings at a table reserved for student delegates with reasonable access to the Board and to the public, and be provided with microphones where appropriate;
- Speak on an item of business under consideration by the Board before discussion by the general public and before the Board votes;
- Receive, prior to each meeting, the public agenda for that meeting;
- Report regularly to their respective student governments in order to keep students informed of current issues and to secure the opinion of the general student body on those issues.
