

REFRIGERANT MANAGEMENT PLAN

Recent legislation prohibits the manufacture of CFCs (chlorofluorocarbons) and the release of this product into the air. To manage the phase out of equipment using CFCs in the most economical manner, the school district shall:

1. Not purchase any equipment that involves the use of CFCs.
2. Replace equipment only after it is determined to be unserviceable and the need for it is confirmed.
3. Replace or retrofit equipment only after a needs survey is completed. This shall be done by the building administration or the Director of Food and Nutrition Services.
4. Not allow the venting of freon (CFCs) into the atmosphere.
5. Permit servicing of refrigerant units only by contractors who are certified technicians.
6. Establish a log to record service or replacement of units.
7. Make periodic checks with LIPA to keep track of any opportunity for rebates when replacing or retrofitting equipment.
