

LATE ACTIVITY BUS TRANSPORTATION

The Board of Education elects to provide late activity bus transportation for the secondary schools in the district.

In accordance with Section 3635 of the Education Law, if late bus service is provided for public school students who remain to participate in particular activities after the normal dismissal hour, such transportation must also be provided for nonpublic school students "in like circumstances."

Therefore, late activity bus service will be provided for resident secondary nonpublic school students, who are otherwise eligible for transportation, under the following conditions:

1. Late bus service will be provided only for nonpublic school students who are engaged in activities similar to those for which late bus service is provided to public school students.
2. All nonpublic school bus transportation, including late bus service, must be requested by parents, in writing, no later than April 1st preceding the school year in which service is to be provided.
3. A minimum daily ridership of five students will be required for the scheduling of a late activity bus at any public or nonpublic school.
4. In the event that ridership on any late activity bus drops below five students per day for ten consecutive days, the run may be cancelled, at the discretion of the Director of Transportation, no sooner than ten days following written parental notification.
