

SUMMER READING SUGGESTIONS

For ESL STUDENTS

Depending on your ESL level, it is recommended that you read the ESL version of one of the following novels during the summer:

ESL Level 1: *The Yearling* by Marjorie Kinnan Rawlings

ESL Level 2: *1984* by George Orwell

ESL Level 3: *Oliver Twist* by Charles Dickens

Do not read the original version of your book. You may pick up the correct version from Mr. Munshine or Mrs. Dorkings in the Study Center (Room 210) from June 8 to June 17. You will be required to fill out a book receipt.

You might also wish to get and watch the movie version of your novel from your local library or Netflix (if your family belongs to it).

It would be a good idea for you to keep a reader's journal in which you write your thoughts about each chapter as you read it.

Be prepared for a possible discussion of your book early in the next school year. Also be prepared to return the book to Mr. Munshine in the Study Center by the end of September.

NOTE – Students who have tested out of ESL must read the book assigned to them for summer reading for the grade in which they will be in the new school year. These assignments will be posted on the school web site before the start of summer vacation.
