

Artwork and photos MUST be original work that combines drawing, pictures, or photography to express the contest theme.

- Materials used may include pencil, ink, charcoal, crayon, markers, pastel, paint, mixed media, collage, graphic design or similar 2D media.
- Scanning your artwork (a painting, drawing, etc.) will give us the best image quality. If you don't have access to a scanner, it's okay to take a picture of it.
- Please submit your photo in a highresolution format.
- Please include a description with your artwork
- Artwork or photos cannot show depictions of nudity, blood, or violence and photos cannot show a person's face.
